Betty's Bay is situated on a coastal strip within the greater Kogelberg Biosphere Reserve. Development in the area has recently increased at an unprecedented rate and this presents challenges and threats for the environmental integrity of this magnificent region.

The Betty's Bay Conservancy (BBC) was initially established in 2005 and officially endorsed by Cape Nature on 1st October the same year. After years of dormancy, Betty's Bay Conservancy was re-constituted in 2021.

The Conservancy was re-launched with the goal of engaging all stakeholders to contribute proactively to maintain and promote the environmental integrity of Betty's Bay and the surrounding area.

The BBC is committed to raising awareness of "BIOSPHERE LIVING" by educating and encouraging residents to protect our natural heritage every day through how we build, live, work and play in Betty's Bay.

- Promote collaborative and effective environmental management through facilitating co-ordinated partnerships between government, the private sector and civil society.
- Support the activities of members and other organisations having objectives consistent with those of the Betty's Bay Conservancy.
- Work and collaborate with neighbouring coastal conservancies in the Kogelberg Biosphere Reserve.
- Raise funds and develop resources to enable the active pursuit of the Conservancy's Vision, Mission, main and secondary Objectives.

Membership of the BBC is R120 per annum for Betty's Bay property owners and residents and R60 per annum for Associate members who reside outside Betty's Bay.

The BBC hosts events and activities on the fourth Saturday of the month.
